Proof of Residency

If you qualify for EITC (Earned Income Tax Credit) or Child Tax Credit (CTC) for a dependent, we need yearly proof of residency to verify that the Child lived with you.

The document needs to contain three things: the child's name, your address, and the current tax year on it.

The following are examples of documents you can bring as proof of residency:

If you are claiming an adult that is permanently and totally disabled please bring one of the
following:
